Did you know that baseball was the first sport ever? The angels had to be the players, of course. Maybe the California Angels were named after one of the teams. Not sure what the original team names were, but Michael had to be the manager of one and Gabriel the manager of another. Surely Lucifer had a team also, until he and his team were expelled for cheating.

Anyway, it seems that in **The Big Inning**, probably during the 7th inning stretch, God was so bored watching the game that He decided to do something different, something exciting. **God decided to create the heavens and the earth!** Wow! That would be quite a show for the angels to watch as they sipped on Gatorade during their 7th inning stretch. We might even call this the “half-time show.”

First God created out of nothing a mass of material that he called planet Earth. Fireworks always attracts a crowd, so to be sure that every angel was watching, God continued with a spectacular when He said, “Let there be light!” This Light began with the beautiful aurora borealis (the northern lights) and the aurora australis (the southern lights) for the very first 12 hour period. Then God turned on His full Light, plenty of it, in every hue and color imaginable! This ice canopy would make a greenhouse effect on the earth, providing a tropical climate over the total surface. I like that, the main reason I live in Florida! The other part of the water He left on the surface of the earth. The large area between the surface of the earth and the ice canopy above, God called the heavens. We generally call it ‘sky,’ using ‘heavens’ for that beyond our planet earth and its atmosphere, or Space which at this point is still empty of any other physical body.

Then God spent the next 24 hours separating the landmasses on the earth from the waters on the surface, forming the continents and the oceans. He looked it over and said, “Shofar Sho Good!” Since He was pleased up to this point, He continued by calling forth all kinds of vegetation: fruit trees with fruit on the branches and edible plants ready to eat, and all other kinds of trees and plants, a beautiful spectacle by daylight to complement the fireworks in the heavens each night. And so God created Life, plant life, able to reproduce after their kind by producing seeds. Vegetation has a growth cycle regulated by 12 hours of light and 12 hours of darkness, absolutely essential for plant life to continue. God was so pleased that He said it twice on this 3rd Day, “Shofar Sho Good!!”

The angels did not mind extending their 7th inning stretch, as this “half-time show” was really getting exciting! They were probably getting bored with their ball game anyway, as there were no families to watch and cheer. They had never seen anything like this before! In fact, God’s throne in heaven was all they knew, serving and worshiping God...and playing baseball during breaks.

Now God dishes up another spectacular during the 4th 24-hour period. Up until this point, the Light that He had sent forth on Day One came from Himself, that radiant Light that surrounds Him and all of His throne area. And also up until this point, planet Earth was the only physical object in Space! But now He creates all the other heavenly bodies and kicks in self-sustaining nuclear reactions, making the sun and all the stars like white-hot furnaces in the vast expanse of the heavens. He names all the stars and places them in a special order as viewed from earth, as these would be the **Signs** in the heavens telling the story of Salvation, or as we say, The Gospel in the Stars!! The earth would now be put in a 24-hour rotation, if it had not been since **The Big Inning** started, so that the sun would now regulate the dark and light sequence necessary for plant growth, called Night and Day. Now comes the 6th 24-hour period, the last Day of God’s creating genius. He is not tired at all since He only speaks and things happen, but even then, it will be a very busy day. He is also enjoying the response of the angels as they *oooo* and *aaaa* over these fascinating results. So then God made all the creatures that live on the land, big ones and small ones, all of them vegetarians and tame. These also have the kind of Life with the ability to reproduce by mating. He said “Shofar Sho Good” for the last time, because the Grand Finale was next! The biggest surprise of all was about to happen to wrap up this 6th Day of **The Big Inning!**

God said, “Let us make mankind in Our Image, after Our Likeness, and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the animals, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.” So God created mankind in His Own Image, male and female, created beings that He could enjoy fellowship with, talk and reason with, love and be loved by them, very different from the angels.

All the previous creation was the setting for His masterpiece, mankind in His Image! Mankind was also created as vegetarians and, with the ability to reproduce, was told to multiply and fill the earth with more human beings. We now have the third kind of Life that God created. First there was plant life. Second there was animal life. Third there is human Life, *vayyitzer* written with two *yods*, whereas animal life is written with only one *yod*, significantly different, possibly indicating that mankind can be a citizen of both earth and heaven, and therefore has a moral dimension to his reasoning that animals do not have, and the ability to be a companion to God Himself.
