We met two of the men in Banaue 8 years ago, when they were backpacking around the world after their army service. Last Wed we had lunch with a former Ambassador of Israel to the Philippines. We became good friends about 10 years ago. Today we will have supper with a couple, both Holocaust survivors from France, who we met in Baguio, Philippines 23 years ago, when they were working there as agriculturalists for a Filipino corporation. Last Monday, a couple from up north, a few miles from Lebanon, dropped by for lunch. As we ate, a neighbor phoned them and said, "Don't come home yet! The bombs are falling again!" But duty called, and they returned by a roundabout way, avoiding Haifa. They are busy helping others there.

When home, we walk to the beach at sunset time, one mile each way, and "swim" one or two mornings a week. It should be more! What a privilege we have! The water temp and waves are wonderful! Last week the lifeguard said something on the PA system, which I did not understand. Soon I came to shore and asked someone what he said. It was, "If you want me to save your life, please come on the other side of the rope." Last week it was THIS side of the rope! Ok, enjoy!

We Rejoice in the LORD Always! What a privilege to have a Bible, to be able to understand it, to Know Him personally and to make Him known to any around us.
